If your company is interested in pursuing the Master Logger designation, you won't want to miss the next scheduled MLP certification course. This is a voluntary, educational program developed by the Washington Contract Loggers Association, that requires about 32 hours of classroom training, plus eight hours of continuing education every year.

Master Logger professionals receive a certificate and wallet card with endorsements, plus recognition for course completion on WCLA's website.

Accreditation requires completion of the four sessions listed below, plus first aid training, which is taught separately. Attendees may complete a partial MLP program, and take the remaining sessions at a later date. Attendees may also register for one or more days to earn continuing education credits (eight per day).
